The 60+ member institutions are consistently recognized as some of the best hospitals and universities in the nation. They treat 10 mio . patients and develop 2500 clinical trials a year. It is a centre for research and innovation with 225+ active start-up lifescience companies.

Texas

- For the 20th year in a row, Texas has been named the Best State for Business
- The state ranks 7th overall in terms of states with the highest growth of women -owned businesses
- Texas leads the nation in job creation over the past 10 years
- 30,5 million residents in Texas (2023) and about 7.2 in the Greater Houston Area
- 2nd biggest state in terms of size and population
- 3rd fastest growing state in the US (2024). Texas ranked first in the nation for number of residents added from 2020 to 2021

- In 2021, Texas grossed more than \$375.3 billion a year in exports – more than the exports of California and New York combined.
- **55 Fortune 500** companies are headquartered in Texas making it the state with the **most fortune** 500 companies in the entire U.S as of 2024
- Texas is ranked the 2nd most diverse state in America, right behind California.
- Texas ranks 1st in the United States as the friendliest business climate i 2023
- Texas has been selected as the no. 2 state for small business job growth in 2022






THE TMC-DK BIOBRIDGE

Denmark has a signed MoU agreement with Texas Medical Center, which formalizes collaboration between the Texan and Danish life science eco -systems. The tactical goals of the BioBridge are to:

- Identify and create tangible business opportunities for Danish companies at Texas institutions and hospitals within medical devices, digital health & tele health, pharma & biotech and operational solutions . From concept through testing to commercialization.
- Transfer knowledge between DK and TX hospital ecosystems regarding pain points and encourage collaboration and pilots to find joint solutions in healthcare.
- Increase international government collaboration between Denmark and the US
